Start line access for media

Credentialed photographers/videographers can access the Bank of America Chicago Marathon start line via bus only. All other entry points to the Chicago Marathon start line will be closed to members of the media. Bus transportation will be provided from the Hilton Chicago (location of the 8th St. entrance; 720 S. Michigan Ave.). Please note that it will not be possible to access the start line on foot.

Please arrive at the 8th St. entrance of the Hilton Chicago at 4:45 a.m. Media members must wear their event issued credential and media ID vest in order to gain access to the buses. A brief security screening will take place before media members board the buses.

Media buses will leave the hotel at exactly 5:20 a.m. After the buses depart, there will be no other way for media to enter the start line media corral.



The buses will drop off media adjacent to the start line at approximately 5:45 a.m. Photographers with BP Bridge access will then be escorted onto the BP Bridge.

After the start of the race, media may leave the photo corral through the Columbus Dr. underpass heading westbound towards Michigan Ave. ([please see access map](#)).

Race day satellite truck parking at start line

To enter the start line media corral in Grant Park on Sunday, satellite trucks must first go through a security screening at 18th St. and Lake Shore Drive. This screening process will open at 4 a.m. After being screened, trucks must head directly to the media corral entrance at Monroe St. and Lake Shore Drive.

Satellite trucks will enter Grant Park off of Lake Shore Drive at Monroe St. Parking will be available for official trucks only; no personal vehicles will be allowed.

Media with trucks will need at most **275 feet of cable to reach start line.**

All trucks must display their event-issued parking placard, including the driver's name and phone number.

BP Bridge

Photographers with BP Bridge credentials must take media transportation to the start line (see above) and will be escorted to the bridge. Please be aware that the **BP Bridge is 750 feet from the start line.**

Course route access for media

Media credentials are not necessary for those who wish to report or shoot photography from areas along the course. Please note while media credentials are not required along the course, there are operational areas of the event, such as on-course medical facilities, that are restricted to members of the media. Members of the media looking to interview event staff or volunteers along the course should contact the Chicago Marathon media relations team at 1.312.294.6708. **No station in the Chicago market may air live video of the Bank of America Chicago Marathon between the hours of 7 a.m. and 11 a.m. (CT).**

Finish line access for media

Credentialed photographers/videographers will be escorted to the Bank of America Chicago Marathon finish line by a member of the media relations team. Credentialed photographers/videographers can access the Bank of America Chicago Marathon finish line via one of two media escorts at 8 a.m. and 8:50 a.m.



Please arrive at the security gate on Balbo Ave. west of Michigan Avenue at 7:50 a.m. or 8:40 a.m. (see access map). Media members must wear their event issued credential and media ID vest in order to gain access to the finish line. A brief security screening will take place before media members are escorted to the finish line media corrals.

At the conclusion of the elite race (approximately 10:30 a.m.), all photographers and videographers will be escorted out of the finish line media corrals.

Only photographers and videographers, with appropriate credentials, are allowed in the media corrals.

No interviews will be conducted in the media corrals. Interviews will be conducted at the media center at the Hilton Chicago, starting at approximately 10:30 a.m.

The event does not provide finish line parking.

Frequency coordination requirement

To assist with coordinating frequencies in and around Grant Park, we are requiring that all media register any wireless communication or broadcast devices with a frequency coordinator. Examples include, but are not limited to, wireless microphones, wireless in-ear monitors, wireless IFBs, wireless intercom, two-way radios, etc.

This process will help ensure your communication does not experience interference pm race day. Mobile phones and devices using 2.4 Ghz or 5.0 Ghz frequencies do not need to be registered.

Exclusive live rights/broadcast constraints

This will serve to inform you that NBC Chicago has the exclusive live broadcast rights to the Bank of America Chicago Marathon on Sunday, October 13, 2019 from 7 a.m. until 11 a.m. and live streaming rights from 7 a.m. until 3 p.m. the same day. **No station in the Chicago market may air live video of the Bank of America Chicago Marathon between the hours of 7 a.m. and 11 a.m. CT.** No entity may live stream worldwide between the hours of 7 a.m. and 3 p.m. CT. Any station in regularly scheduled live news programs during the hours of 7 a.m. until 11 a.m. CT may be provided guests for live and taped interviews by Chicago Marathon media



relations team, however **no marathon event course and race footage obtained beginning at 7 a.m. may be aired in the Chicago market until after 11 a.m.**

We thank you for respecting these rights. Highlights will be fed out and may be utilized, in addition to any videotaped footage captured during the event, by regularly scheduled news and sports programs.
