NBC 5 Chicago and Telemundo Chicago will provide complete live coverage of the Bank of America Chicago Marathon in English and Spanish from 7 a.m. – 11 a.m. CST on Sunday, October 8. Expert analysts Ed Eyestone, Carrie Tollefson and Amanda McGrory will join Marion Brooks and Leila Rahimi on NBC 5 Chicago, with Juan Luis Barrios, Luis Posso and Saul Mendoza joining Anabel Monge and Héctor Lozano on Telemundo Chicago. Covering the leaders and reporting along the course will be Keira D'Amato for the women's professional open division race and Olympian Diego Estrada for the men's professional open division race. A talented array of NBC and Telemundo reporters will join the broadcast at the start, finish and along the course.

The 45th running of the race, as well as four hours of finish-line coverage, will be streamed live nationally and in Mexico on Peacock and Roku from 7 a.m. to 3 p.m. CST, as well as on nbcchicago.com, telemundochicago.com and nbcsportschicago.com and the NBC Chicago, Telemundo Chicago and NBC Sports Chicago apps.
